Psalm 119:1-2

Contented are those whose way is blameless, who walk in the Torah of Adonai! **Contented** are those who keep His testimonies, who seek Him with their whole heart.

⊓פץ (*chophetz*) **"delight/take pleasure in"**

Psalm 40:8

I **delight** to do Your will, O my God. Your Torah is within my heart.

Psalm 34:12-13

[Q:] Who is the man who **desires** life and loves length of days that he may see good? [A:] Keep your tongue from evil, and your lips from speaking deceit.

הגה (*hagah*) **"meditate"**

Jeremiah 17:8

He is like a tree planted by water, that sends out its roots by the stream, and does not fear when heat comes, for its leaves remain green, and is not anxious in the year of drought, for it does not cease to bear fruit.

צלח

(*tzalach*)

"bring to a successful conclusion"

Joshua 1:8

This Book of the Torah shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall **meditate** on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way **successful**, and then you will prosper.
