Psalm 11

To the choirmaster. Of David.

1-2

In Adonai I take refuge. How can you say to my soul, "Flee like a bird to your mountain"? [or *"Your mountain has fled like a bird."*] ² For behold, the wicked bend the bow. They have fitted **their arrow** to the string to shoot in the dark at the upright in heart.³

חצם (*chitzam*) This form 2x – Ps.64:4

Q: If the **settled things** are destroyed, what can the righteous man do?

שת (sheit)

"Seth" (9x) / "buttocks"(2x) / "spinners"(1x) / "pillars"(1x)

4-7

A: Adonai is in His holy temple; Adonai's throne is in heaven. His eyes see; His eyelids test the children of man. ⁵ Adonai tests the righteous, but His soul hates the wicked and the one who loves violence. ⁶ He will rain snares on the wicked. Fire and sulfur and a scorching wind shall be the portion of their cup. ⁷ For Adonai is righteous; He loves righteous deeds. The upright shall behold His face.

REFERENCES:

Verse 2

Psalm 64:2-4 Hide me from the secret plots of the wicked, from the throng of evildoers, who whet their tongues like swords, who aim bitter words like <u>arrows</u> [חצם, *chitzam*], shooting from ambush at the blameless, shooting at him suddenly and without fear.

Verse 3

Genesis 4:25 And Adam knew his wife again, and she bore a son and called his name <u>Seth</u> (*w*, *sheit*), for she said, "God has appointed for me another offspring instead of Abel, for Cain killed him."

2 Samuel 10:4 So Chanun took David's servants and shaved off half the beard of each and cut off their garments in the middle, at their <u>buttocks</u> [nv, *sheit*] and sent them away. (+Isaiah 20:4)

Isaiah 19:9-10 The workers in combed flax will be in despair, and the weavers of white cotton. Those who are the <u>spinners</u> (שת, *sheit*) of the land will be crushed, and all who work for pay will be grieved.

If the foundations, the moral and societal foundations of the world, **are destroyed, what can** *the righteous man do?* When the moral foundations of society are in ruins, what good can possibly come of the individual deeds of a righteous person? (R' Adin Steinsaltz)

Ephesians 2:5 Even when we were dead in our trespasses, [God] made us alive together with Messiah – by grace you have been saved – and raised us up with Him and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Messiah Yeshua.

Verse 4-5

Psalm 7:9 Oh, let the evil of the wicked come to an end, and may You establish the righteous – You who <u>test</u> the minds and hearts, O righteous God!

Verse 6

Proverbs 22:5 Thorns and <u>snares</u> (פחים, *pachim*] are in the way of the crooked; whoever guards his soul will keep far from them.

Genesis 19:24 Then Adonai rained on Sodom and Gomorrah <u>sulfur</u> and fire from Adonai out of heaven.

Verse 7

Psalm 97:11 Light is sown for the righteous, and joy for the upright in heart.
