KI TEITZEI – קִי תִצֵּא

Deuteronomy 21:10-25:19

Ki Teitzei covers 31 different topics and contains 72 positive and negative commandments.

Shoftim ends with:

“...when you do what is upright in the eyes of Adonai.”

Ki Teitzei begins with:

*“When you go out to **war**...”*

(*mil'chamah*)

לחם
(*lechem*)
“bread”

Deuteronomy 21:17

Rather, he must acknowledge the **firstborn**, the son of the unloved, by giving him a double portion of all that **he has**, for he is the first fruits of his strength. The right of the **firstborn** is his.

(*bachor*)

ב = 2

כ = 20

ו = 11

ך = 200

Deuteronomy 22:10

You shall not **plow** with an ox and a donkey together.

תחרֹשׁ

(*tacharosh*)

Occurs 2x

Proverbs 3:29

Do not **plot evil** against your neighbor, who dwells trustingly beside you.

Deuteronomy 23:13

And you shall have a tent peg with your weapons, and when you sit down outside, **you shall dig** a hole with it and turn back and cover up your excrement.

וחפרתה

(*v'chaphartah*)

Occurs 2x

Job 11:18

You will be confident, because there is hope; **you will dig** around you and lie down secure.

Deuteronomy 25:3

Forty stripes may be given him, but not more, lest, if one should go on to beat him with more stripes than these, **your brother** be degraded in your sight.

אחיך = 39

(*achei'cha*)

2 Corinthians 11:24

Five times I received at the hands of the Jews the **forty lashes less one**.

Deuteronomy 25:19

Therefore when Adonai your God has given you rest from all your enemies around you, in the land that Adonai your God is giving you for an inheritance to possess, **you shall blot out the memory of Amalek** from under heaven. You shall not forget.
