LECH LECHA - לך לך

Genesis 12-17

Genesis 2:4

These are the generations of the heavens and the earth **when they were created**, in the day that Adonai Elohim made the earth and the heavens.

באברהם

(*ba'Avraham*)

“for Abrham”

Genesis 13:11

So Lot chose for himself all the Jordan Valley, and Lot **journeyed east**. Thus they separated from each other.

...מקדם ויפרדו איש מעל אחיו:

שלום

(*shalom*)

“peace”

Genesis 16:5

And Sarai said to Abram, “May the wrong done to me be on you! I gave my servant to your embrace, and when she saw that she had conceived, she looked on me with contempt. May Adonai judge between me **and between you!**”

וביניך

(*uveinecha*)

Genesis 17:5

“No longer shall your name be called **Abram**, but your name shall be **Abraham**, for I have made you the father of a multitude of nations.”

Genesis 17:15

And God said to Abraham, “As for Sarai your wife, you shall not call her name **Sarai**, but **Sarah** shall be her name. “
