

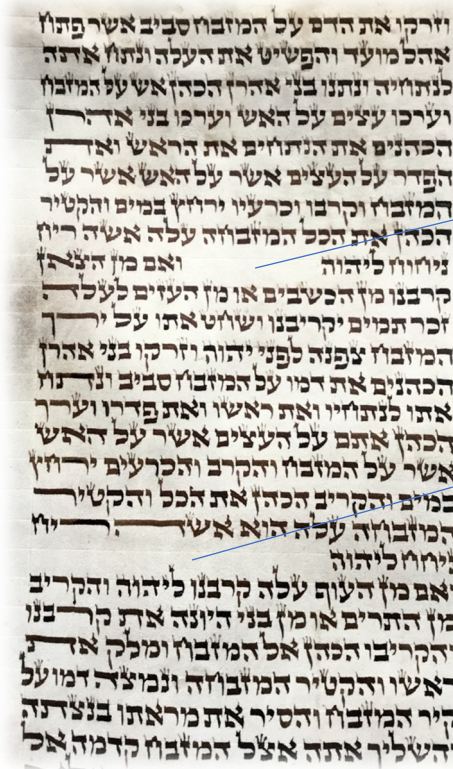


PARSHAH SEASONINGS

Genesis 28:10-32:3

Vayeitzei is one long unbroken paragraph.

Genesis 28:12

And he dreamed, and behold, there was a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven. And behold, the angels of God were ascending and descending **on it!**

בו

(bo)

or

“on him”

John 1:51

And he said to him, “Truly, truly, I say to you, you will see heaven opened, and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man.”

Genesis 29:10

... Jacob came near and rolled the stone from the well's mouth **and he watered** the flock of Laban his mother's brother.

וישק

(*va'yishak*)

or

“and he kissed”

Genesis 29:11

Then Jacob **kissed** Rachel and wept aloud.

Genesis 30:23-24

She conceived and bore a son and said, “God has **taken away** [אסף] my reproach.” And she called his name **Joseph** [יוסף], saying, “May Adonai **add** [יסף] to me another son!”

Genesis 31:20

And Jacob **deceived** Laban the Aramean, by not telling him that he was fleeing.

ויגנב יעקב את לב

(*vayig'nov Ya'akov et lev*)

“and he stole the heart of”

REFERENCES:

Genesis 49:1 Then Jacob called his sons and said, “Gather [אסף, *asaph*] yourselves together, that I may tell you what shall happen to you in days to come.”

Exodus 34:22 You shall observe the Feast of Weeks, the firstfruits of wheat harvest, and the Feast of Ingathering [אסוף, *asiph*] at the year's end.

Genesis 31:26 Then Laban said to Jacob, “What have you done by stealing my heart [ותגנב את לבבי, *vatic'nov et l'aviv*] and carrying away my daughters like captives of the sword?”
