VAYECHI - יתי

Genesis 47:28-50:26

Genesis 48:22

"And I give you one **portion** more than your brothers, which I took from the hand of the Amorite with my sword and my bow."

שכם "Shechem"

Genesis 49:1

Then Jacob called his sons and said, "Gather yourselves together, that I may tell you what shall happen to you in the latter days."

באחרית הימים (*b'acharit ha'yamim*) 1st occurrence

Genesis 49:8

"Judah, your brothers shall praise you. Your hand shall be on the neck of your enemies. Your father's sons shall bow down before you."

יהודה יהודה יהודה

Genesis 49:10

The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until Shiloh comes, and to Him shall be the obedience of the peoples.

משיח = 358 = יבא שילה (yavo Shiloh) "Mashiach"

Genesis 49:18 I wait for your salvation, Adonai.

The **end** of Jacob's Blessings

Genesis 49:28 All these are the twelve tribes of Israel. **And this** is what their father said to them as he blessed them, blessing each with the blessing suitable to him.

The start of Moses' Blessings

Deuteronomy 33:1 And this is the blessing with which Moses the man of God blessed the people of Israel before his death.

Genesis 49:24

Yet his bow remained unmoved. His arms were made agile by the hands of the Mighty One of Jacob (from there is the Shepherd, the **Stone** of Israel).

Messianic Parallels Between Joseph & Yeshua

Chapter 47

• Israel will bow to "the son" (31)

Chapter 48

• The father's blessings come through "the son" (9)

Chapter 50

- He turns evil into good (20)
- He sustains those he saves (21)

RESOURCES:

Genesis 9:23 Then Shem and Japheth took a garment, laid it on both their shoulders [DNW, Shechem], and walked backward and covered the nakedness of their father. Their faces were turned backward, and they did not see their father's nakedness.

Joshua 24:32 As for the bones of Joseph, which the people of Israel brought up from Egypt, they buried them at <u>Shechem</u>, in the piece of land that Jacob bought from the sons of Chamor the father of Shechem for a hundred *kesitas*. It became an inheritance of the descendants of Joseph.

Genesis 29:35 And [Leah] conceived again and bore a son, and said, "This time I will <u>praise</u> [אורה, *odeh*] Adonai." Therefore she called his name Judah (יהורה, *Yehudah*). Then she ceased bearing.

Genesis 50:20 "As for you, you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good, to bring it about that many people should be kept alive, as they are today."

Genesis 50:21 "So do not fear. I will provide for you and your little ones." Thus he comforted them and spoke kindly to them.
