And now do not be distressed and **do not be angry** with yourselves because you sold me here, **for a life-sustainer** God sent me before you.

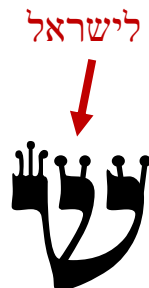
למחיה

Messianic Parallels Between Joseph & Yeshua

Chapter 45

- He reveals himself to his brothers during seven years of tribulation (1)
- Is the “resurrection and the life” (5)
- Sent to procure a mighty deliverance (7)
- They approach the father in the name of the son (9)
- Brings the father's presence into the world (9)
- Gives to others what was taken from him (22)
- Was thought dead, but lives! (26)
- Gives life to Jacob/Israel (27-28)

Chapter 46

- Established Israel in the with favor in the world (31)

Chapter 47

- Israel blesses the nations (6-7)
 - Gives Israel a choice inheritance (11)
 - Resurrects the dead (25)

RESOURCES:

*“You are eternally mighty, my Lord, the **Resurrector** [מַחְיֶה, **m'chayeh**] of the dead are You, with abundant power to save. Who sustains the living with kindness, **resurrects** [מַחְיֶה, **m'chayeh**] the dead with abundant mercy, supports the fallen, heals the sick, releases the bound, and maintains His faith to those asleep in the dust. Who is like You, O master of mighty deeds, and who is comparable to You, O King who causes death and **restores life** [מַחְיֶה, **m'chayeh**] and makes salvation [lit. ‘Yeshua’] flourish! And You are faithful to **resurrect** [לְהַחְיֹת, **I'ha'chayot**] the dead. Blessed are You, Adonai, who **resurrects** [מַחְיֶה, **m'chayeh**] the dead.”*
