Exodus 6:2-9:35

Exodus 6:2-3

God spoke to Moses and said to him, “I am Adonai. **And I appeared** to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, as El Shaddai, but by my name יהוה-יהוה I did not make Myself known to them.”

Exodus 6:9

Moses spoke thus to the people of Israel, but they did not listen to Moses, because of their shortness of **breath** and hard work.

(*ruach*)

“spirit”

Exodus 6:27

They were the ones who spoke to Pharaoh king of Egypt about bringing out the people of Israel from Egypt, **he** was Moses and Aaron.

הֵם

(*hem*)

“they”

הוּא

(*hu*)

“he”

Exodus 7:12

For each man cast down his staff, and they became serpents. But Aaron's staff swallowed up **their staffs**.

מטתם

(*matotam*)

2x in Tanach

Numbers 17:6

Moses spoke to the people of Israel. And all their chiefs gave him staffs, one for each chief, according to their fathers' houses, twelve staffs. And the staff of Aaron was among **their staffs**.

Exodus 8:14 [10]

And they heaped them together in piles, and the land stank.

Genesis 41:35

“And let them gather all the food of these good years that are coming **and heap up** grain under the authority of Pharaoh for food in the cities and let them keep it.”

Exodus 8:19 [23]

“Thus, I will put a **division** between my people and your people. Tomorrow this sign shall happen.”

(*pedut*)

“redemption”

4x in Tanach

Exodus 9:24

There was hail **and fire flashing** continually in the midst of the hail, very heavy hail, such as had never been in all the land of Egypt since it became a nation.

2x in Tanach

Ezekiel 1:4

As I looked, behold, a stormy wind came out of the north, and a great cloud, with brightness around it, **and fire flashing** forth continually, and in the midst of the fire, as it were gleaming metal.

Abraham (3x):

Genesis 12:7 Then Adonai **appeared** to Abram and said, "To your offspring I will give this land." So he built there an altar to Adonai, who had appeared to him.

Genesis 17:1 When Abram was ninety-nine years old Adonai **appeared** to Abram and said to him, "I am El Shaddai; walk before Me, and be blameless."

Genesis 18:1 And Adonai **appeared** to him by the oaks of Mamre, as he sat at the door of his tent in the heat of the day.

Isaac (2x):

Genesis 26:2 And Adonai **appeared** to him and said, "Do not go down to Egypt; dwell in the land of which I shall tell you."

Genesis 26:24 And Adonai **appeared** to him the same night and said, "I am the God of Abraham your father. Fear not, for I am with you and will bless you and multiply your offspring for My servant Abraham's sake."

Jacob (1x):

Genesis 35:9 God **appeared** to Jacob again, when he came from Paddan-aram, and blessed him.

Matthew 5:3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."

Deuteronomy 9:20 "And Adonai was so angry with Aaron that He was ready to destroy him. And I prayed for Aaron also at the same time."

1 Samuel 15:23 "For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft/divination, and presumption is as iniquity and idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of Adonai, He has also rejected you from being king."

Psalms 111:9 He sent **redemption** [*pedut*] to His people; He has commanded His covenant forever. Holy and awesome is His name!

Psalms 130:7 O Israel, hope in Adonai! For with Adonai there is steadfast love, and with Him is plentiful **redemption** [*pedut*].

Isaiah 50:2 Why, when I came, was there no man? Why, when I called, was there no one to answer? Is My hand shortened, that it cannot **redeem** [*pedut*]? Or have I no power to deliver? ...
