Exodus 30:11-12

Adonai said to Moses, "When you lift up the head of the sons of Israel according to their numbers, each man shall give an atonement for his soul to Adonai, that there be no plague among them when you count them."

Matthew 17:24-27

When they came to Capernaum, the collectors of the two-drachma [half shekel] tax went up to Peter and said, "Does your Teacher not pay the tax?" He said, "Yes." And when he came into the house, Yeshua spoke to him first, saying, "What do you think, Simon? From whom do kings of the earth take toll or tax? From their sons or from others?" And when he said, "From others," Yeshua said to him, "Then the sons are free. However, not to give offense to them, go to the sea and cast a hook and take the first fish that comes up, and when you open its mouth you will find a shekel. Take that and give it to them for Me and for yourself."

Exodus 30:13

Each one who is numbered in the census shall give this: half a shekel according to the shekel of the sanctuary (the shekel is twenty gerahs), half a shekel as an offering to Adonai.

Exodus 30:34

Adonai said to Moses, "Take sweet spices, stacte, and onycha, and galbanum, sweet spices with **pure** frank-incense ..."

זכה (*zacah*) 3x in Tanach

Leviticus 24:7

And you shall put **pure** frankincense on each pile, that it may go with the bread as a memorial portion as a food offering to Adonai.

Job 16:17

Though there is no violence in my hands, and my prayer is **pure**.

Psalm 141:2

Let my prayer be counted as incense before You ...!

The 13 Attributes of Mercy

Exodus 34:5-7

And Adonai <u>descended</u> (יהודן, *v'yared*) in the cloud and stood there with him as he called upon the name of Adonai. ⁶ Then <u>Adonai</u> (יהודן) passed by in front of him and proclaimed, "[1] Adonai, [2] Adonai, [3] El, [4] compassionate and [5] gracious, [6] slow to anger, and [7] <u>abounding</u> [זור, *v'rav*] in lovingkindness and [8] truth; ⁷ who [9] keeps lovingkindness for thousands [of generations], who [10] forgives iniquity, [11] transgression and [12] sin, and who [13] <u>cleanses</u> [זוקה, *v'nakeih*] – but does not cleanse completely, visiting the iniquity of fathers on the children and on the grandchildren to the third and fourth generations."

Exodus 34:5-7
