Psalm 30

Of David. A psalm, a song for **dedication** of the house. שיר מזמור (mizmor) (shir)

חנכה

(*chanukah*)

1-3

I will raise You up, Adonai, for You have drawn me up and have not let my foes rejoice over me.² Adonai my God, I cried out to You, and You healed me.

ענעק (shava) שוע (גענק (tza'ak)

³ Adonai, You have brought up my soul from **the grave**. You restored me to life from among those who go down to the pit.

שאול (Sheol)

4-5

Sing to Adonai, O you His beloved ones, and give thanks on recalling His holiness. ⁵ For His anger is but for a moment; life is His will. Weeping may tarry for the night, but joy comes with the morning.

חיים ברצונו

(chaim bir'tzono)

6-10

As for me, I said in my **time of ease**, "I shall never be shaken." ⁷ By Your will, Adonai, You made my strength a mountain. You hid Your face; I panicked! ⁸ To You, Adonai, I cried, and to the Lord I pleaded: ⁹ "What profit is there in my blood, if I go down to the pit? Will the dust praise You? Will it tell of Your faithfulness? ¹⁰ Hear, Adonai, and be merciful to me! Adonai, be my Helper!"

שלו (*shalu*) "quiet ease"

11-12

You have turned for me my mourning into dancing. You have loosed my sackcloth and clothed me with gladness, ¹² that my glory may sing Your praise and not be silent. Adonai my God, I will give thanks to You forever!

Approbation

1 Chronicles 28:11-12 Then David gave Solomon his son the plan of the vestibule of the Temple, and of its houses, its treasuries, its upper rooms, and its inner chambers, and of the room for the [ark] cover, and the plan of all that he had in mind for the courts of the house of Adonai, all the surrounding chambers, the treasuries of the house of God, and the treasuries for dedicated gifts.

Verse 3

Psalm 16:10 For you will not abandon my soul to <u>Sheol</u> or let Your holy one see corruption.

Ephesians 4:8-10 Therefore it says, "When He ascended on high hHe led a host of captives, and He gave gifts to men." (In saying, "He ascended," what does it mean but that He had also descended into the lower regions, the earth? He who descended is the One who also ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.) [Quoting Psalm 68:18]

Verse 5

Exodus 33:5 For Adonai had said to Moses, "Say to the people of Israel, 'You are a stiff-necked people; if for <u>a moment</u> [דגע], *rega*] I should go up among you, I would consume you. So now take off your ornaments, that I may know what to do with you."

Verse 9

Genesis 37:26 Then Judah said to his brothers, "<u>What profit</u> מה בצע], *mah betza*] is it if we kill our brother and conceal his blood?"

John 2:17-22 His disciples remembered that it was written, 'Zeal for Your house will consume me." So the Judeans said to Him, "What sign do You show us for doing these things?" Yeshua answered them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." The Judeans then said, "It has taken forty-six years to build this temple, and will You raise it up in three days?" But He was speaking about the temple of His body. When therefore He was raised from the dead, His disciples remembered that He had said this, and they believed the Scripture and the word that Yeshua had spoken.

Mark 15:29 And those who passed by derided Him, wagging their heads and saying, "Aha! You who would destroy the temple and rebuild it in three days..."

Hebrews 10:19-20 Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Yeshua, by the new and living way that He opened for us through the curtain, that is, through His flesh...
