

## TEHILLIM TALKS

Psalm 32

A Maskil of David.

משכיל (*maskil*)

1-4

Contented is the one whose **transgression** is **borne** away, whose **sin** is covered. <sup>2</sup> Contented is the man against whom Adonai counts no **iniquity**, and in whose spirit there is no deceit. <sup>3</sup> For when I remained deaf, my bones wasted away through my groaning (or 'roaring') all day long. <sup>4</sup> For day and night Your hand was heavy upon me. My sap was dried up as by the summer heat. *Selah*

I acknowledged my sin to You, and I did not **cover** my iniquity. When I merely said, "I will confess my transgressions to Adonai," You had already borne away the iniquity of my sin. *Selah* 

כסה (casah) "cover (so as to conceal from view)"

תמאת (*chatat*)
"sin/error"

עון (*avon*) "guilt/iniquity"

yws (pesha) "transgression"

[For this every godly person **prays** to You at a time when You may be found: only that the rush of great waters will not reach him.] <sup>7</sup> You are a hiding place for me. You preserve me from trouble. You surround me with songs of deliverance [through escape]. *Selah* 

פלל (palal) "to judge/see accurately"

פלט (paleit) "deliverance [through escape]" I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go. I will counsel you with My eye. <sup>9</sup> Be not like a horse or a mule, without understanding, ornamented with muzzle and bridle so that they do not come near you. <sup>10</sup> Many are the sorrows of the wicked, but steadfast love surrounds the one who trusts in Adonai. <sup>11</sup> Be glad in Adonai, and rejoice, O righteous, and shout for joy, all you upright in heart!

# **Approbation**

**Genesis 3:6** So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was to be desired to give intelligence [לכל, sachal], she took of its fruit and ate...

## Verse 1

Leviticus 16:22 The goat shall <u>bear away</u> [NU], *nasa*] all their iniquities on itself to a remote area, and he shall let the goat go free in the wilderness.

Micah 7:19 ... You will cast all our sins into the depths of the sea.

#### Verse 2

Psalm 1:1-2 Contented [יקש'ג, ashrei] is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; but his delight is in the Torah of Adonai, and on His Torah he meditates day and night.

**Romans 4:7-8** "Blessed are those whose lawless deeds are forgiven, and whose sins are covered; blessed is the man against whom the Lord will not count his sin."

## Verse 3

**Psalm 22:1** "My God, my God, why have You forsaken me? Why are You so far from saving me, from the words of my <u>groaning</u> [אַגּה, sh'agah]?"

**2 Corinthians 5:19** ... in Messiah God was reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation.

#### Verse 5

**Genesis 7:19-20** And the waters prevailed so mightily on the earth that all the high mountains under the whole heaven were covered [מסה, casah]. The waters prevailed above the mountains, covering [מסה, casah] them fifteen cubits deep.

**Genesis 9:23** Then Shem and Japheth took a garment, laid it on both their shoulders, and walked backward and <u>covered</u> [מכס, *casah*] the nakedness of their father...

Proverbs 28:13 Whoever covers [כמה, casah] his transgressions will not prosper, but he who confesses and forsakes them will obtain mercy.

**1 Peter 4:8** Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins. [+Proverbs 10:12]

Proverbs 10:12 Hatred stirs up strife, but love covers [כסה, casah] all transgressions.

**Genesis 6:14** Make yourself an ark of gopher wood. Make rooms in the ark, and <u>cover</u> [כפר], *caphar*] it inside and out with <u>pitch</u> [כפר].

## Verse 6

**Isaiah 55:6** Seek Adonai while He may be found; call upon Him while He is near.

**Genesis 48:11** And Israel said to Joseph, "I never <u>envisioned</u> [פלל] palal] to see your face; and behold, God has let me see your offspring also."

**Psalm 106:30** Then Phinehas stood up and <u>executed judgment</u> [פּלֹל], *palal*], and the plague was stayed.

**Philippians 4:6-7** Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by <u>prayer</u> and <u>supplication</u> with <u>thanksgiving</u> let your <u>requests</u> be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Messiah Yeshua.

## Verse 7

**Psalm 22:4** In You our fathers trusted. They trusted, and You <u>delivered</u> [through escape] them.

**Psalm 22:8** "He trusts in Adonai; let Him <u>deliver</u> [through escape]. Let Him rescue him, for He delights in him!"

## Verse 8

**2 Corinthians 5:7** For we walk by faith, not by sight.
