

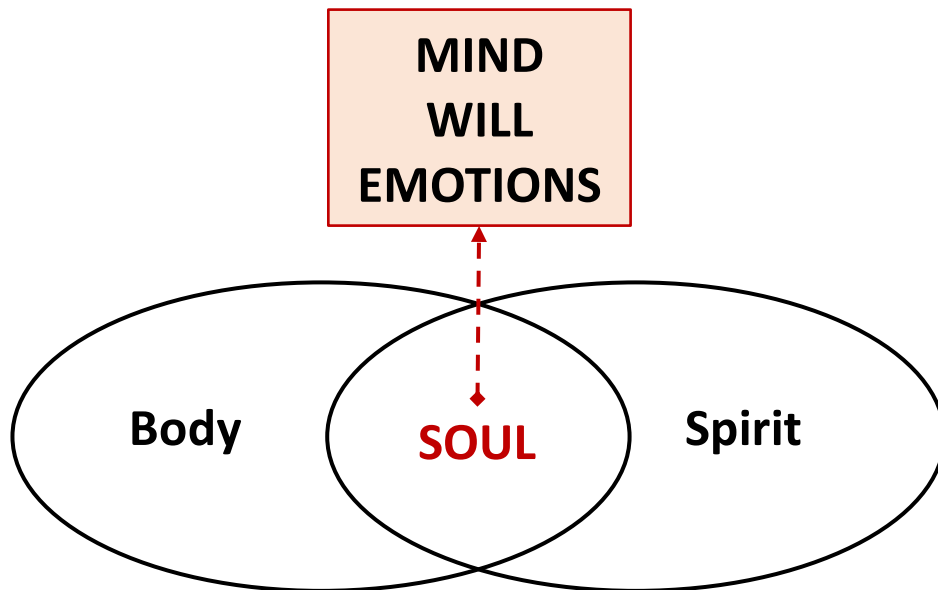


### 1 Thessalonians 5:23

Then Adonai God formed the man of **dust** from the ground and breathed into his nostrils the **breath of life**, and the man became a **living soul**.

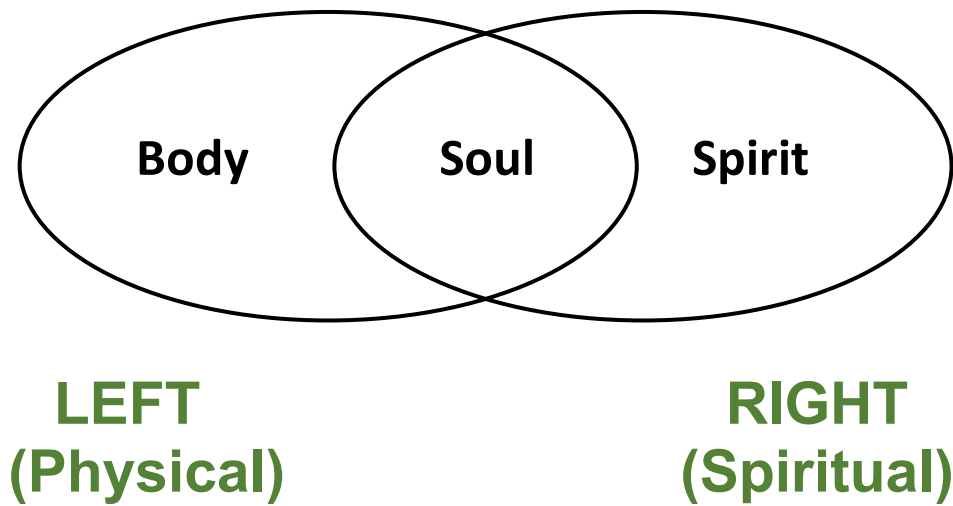


### Romans 8:5-9

For those who live according to the **flesh** set their minds on **fleshly** things, but those who live according to the **spirit** set their minds on **spiritual** things. For to set the mind on the **flesh** is death, but to set the mind on the **spirit** is life and peace. For the mind that is set on the **flesh** is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's Torah; indeed, it cannot. Those who are in the **flesh** cannot please God. You, however, are not in the **flesh** but in the **spirit**, if in fact the **spirit** of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the **spirit** of Messiah does not belong to Him.

### Galatians 5:16-17

But I say, walk by the **spirit**, and you will not gratify the desires of the **flesh**. For the desires of the **flesh** are against the **spirit**, and the desires of the **spirit** are against the **flesh**, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do.



**Ecclesiastes 10:2** A wise man's heart is to the **right**, but a fool's heart is to the **left**.

**Genesis 48:14** And Israel stretched out his **right** hand and laid it on the head of Ephraim, who was the younger, and his **left** hand on the head of Manasseh, crossing his hands (for Manasseh was the firstborn).
