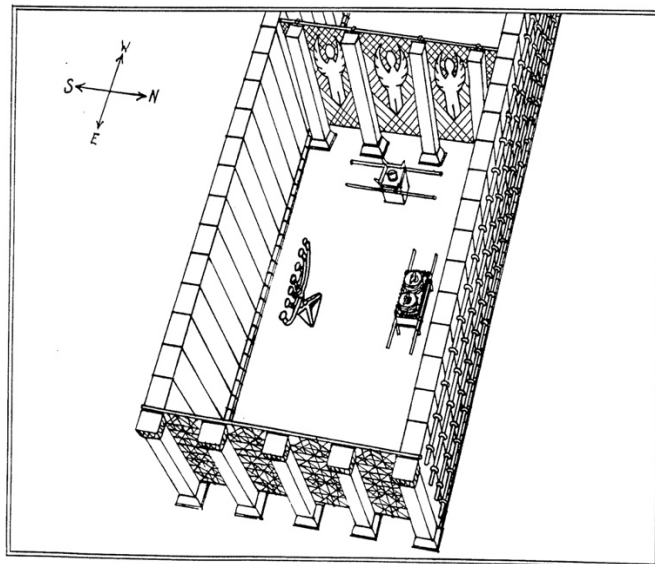
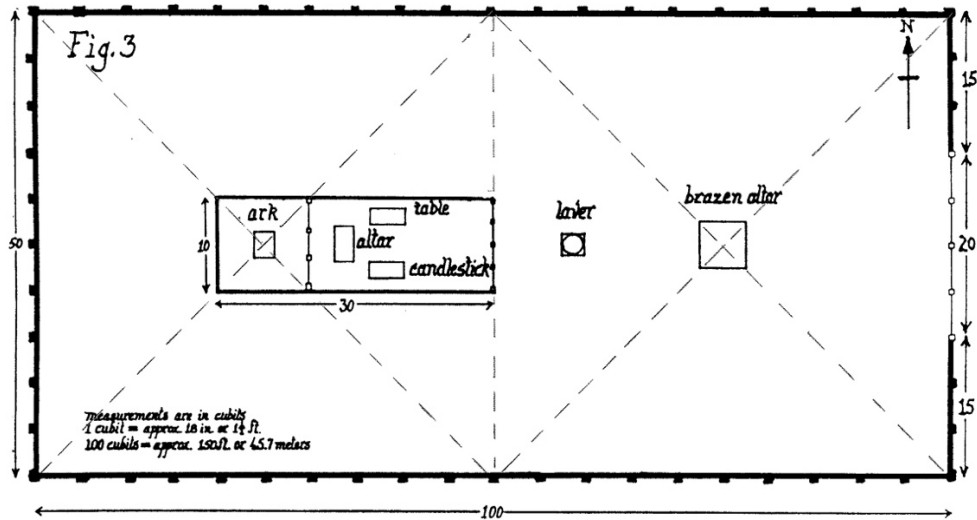




#2: THE SOUL-SPIRIT CONNECTION

REFERENCES:

Genesis 3:23-24 Therefore Adonai Elohim sent him out from the garden of Eden to work the ground from which he was taken. He drove out the man, and at the east of the garden of Eden he placed the cherubim and a flaming sword that turned every way to guard the way to the tree of life.

Exodus 25:8 “And let them make Me a sanctuary, that I may dwell in their midst [ושכנתי בתוכם, *v'shachanti b'tocham*].”

or

“...that I may dwell within them.”

Psalms 19:7 The Torah of Adonai is perfect, reviving the soul; the testimony of Adonai is sure, making wise the simple;

Jeremiah 6:16 Thus says Adonai: “Stand by the roads, and look, and ask for the ancient paths, where the good way is; and walk in it, and find rest for your souls.” But they said, “We will not walk in it.”

Matthew 11:29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

Psalms 23:2-3 He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for His name's sake.

2 Corinthians 7:1 Since we have these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from every defilement of body and spirit, bringing holiness to completion in the fear of God.

Psalms 31:5 Into Your hand I commit my spirit; You have redeemed me, Adonai, faithful God.

Psalms 77:6 I said, “Let me remember my song in the night; let me meditate in my heart.” Then my spirit made a diligent search:

Isaiah 26:9 My soul yearns for You in the night; my spirit within me earnestly seeks You. For when Your judgments are in the earth, the inhabitants of the world learn righteousness.

Daniel 2:3 And the king said to them, “I had a dream, and my spirit is troubled to know the dream.”

Acts 7:59 They went on stoning Stephen as he called on the Lord and said, “Lord Yeshua, receive my spirit!”

Romans 1:9 For God, whom I serve in my spirit in the gospel of His Son, is my witness as to how unceasingly I make mention of you.

1 Corinthians 14:14 For if I pray in a tongue, my spirit prays but my mind is unfruitful.

1 Corinthians 16:18 For they refreshed my spirit as well as yours. Give recognition to such people.
