A Psalm of the Sons of Korah.

1-4

Clap your hands, all peoples! Shout to God with loud songs of joy! ² For Adonai, the Most High, is to be feared, a great King over all the earth. ³ He subdued peoples under us, and nations under our feet. ⁴ He chose our heritage for us, the pride of Jacob whom He loves. *Selah*

5-9

God has gone up with a shout, Adonai with the sound of a trumpet. ⁶ Sing praises to God, sing praises! Sing praises to our King, sing praises! ⁷ For God is the King of all the earth; sing praises with a *maskil* [ie. keen understanding]. ⁸ God reigns over the nations; God sits on His holy throne. ⁹ **The princes (the generous/the willing)** of the peoples gather as the people of the God of Abraham. For the shields/protectors of the earth belong to God. He is highly exalted!

Verse 1

Psalm 98:8 Let the rivers clap their hands; let the hills sing for joy together.

Isaiah 55:12 “For you shall go out in joy and be led forth in peace; the mountains and the hills before you shall break forth into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands.”

Verse 2

Zechariah 14:9 And Adonai will be king over all the earth. On that day Adonai will be one and His name one.

Verse 3

Ezekiel 16:10 I clothed you also with embroidered cloth and sandals of *tachash skin* (תַּחַשׁ) on your feet. I wrapped you in fine linen and covered you with silk.

Verse 9

Ephesians 3:6 This mystery is that the Gentiles are fellow heirs, members of the same body, and partakers of the promise in Messiah Yeshua through the gospel.

Exodus 35:5, 22 Take from among you a contribution to Adonai. Whoever is of a generous (נדיב, *nadiv*) heart, let him bring Adonai's contribution: gold, silver, and bronze ...Then all those of willing (נדיב, *nadiv*) heart, both men and women, came and brought brooches and earrings and signet rings and bracelets, all articles of gold; so did every man who presented an offering of gold to Adonai.

Psalms 51:12 Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, and uphold me with a willing (נדיב, *nadiv*) spirit.
