Psalm 61

# To the choirmaster: with stringed instruments. Of David.

1-4

Hear, O God, my [glad] song, listen to my prayer. <sup>2</sup> From the end of the earth I call to You. When my heart is faint, You lead me to the **rock** that is higher than I, <sup>3</sup> for You have been my **refuge**, a strong **tower** against the enemy. <sup>4</sup> Let me dwell in Your **tent** forever! Let me take refuge under the shelter of Your **wings**! *Selah*

## Verse 1

**1Kings 8:28** "Yet have regard to the prayer of Your servant and to his plea, Adonai my God, listening to the <u>cry</u> (דנה, *rinah*) and to the prayer that Your servant prays before You this day." [1<sup>st</sup> app.]

**Zephaniah 3:17** Adonai your God is in your midst, a mighty One who will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness; He will quiet you by his love; He will exult over you with <u>loud singing</u> (רנה, rinah) [or shouts of joy]. [Last app.]

**Psalm 65:1** Praise is due to You, O God, in Zion, and to You shall vows be performed.

### Verse 7

**Exodus 34:6** Adonai passed before him and proclaimed, "Adonai, Adonai, God, merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in <u>lovingkindness and truth</u>."
