

Genesis 17:19 God said, "No, but Sarah your wife shall bear you a son, and <u>you shall call his name Isaac</u>. I will establish My covenant with him as an everlasting covenant for his offspring after him."

Luke 1:13 But the angel said to him, "Do not be afraid, Zechariah, for your prayer has been heard, and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John."

Genesis 17:17 Then Abraham <u>fell on his face and laughed</u> and said to himself, "Shall a child be born to a man who is a hundred years old? Shall Sarah, who is ninety years old, bear a child?"

Luke 1:11-12 And there appeared to him an angel of the Lord standing on the right side of the altar of incense. And Zechariah was troubled when he saw him, and <u>fear fell upon him</u>.

Genesis 22:2 He said, "Take your son, <u>your only son</u> Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of <u>Moriah</u>, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you."

2Chronicles 3:1 Then Solomon began to build the house of Adonai in Jerusalem on Mount Moriah, where Adonai had appeared to David his father ...

John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that He gave <u>his only Son</u>, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

Genesis 22:6 And Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering and laid it on Isaac his son. And he took in his hand the fire and the knife. So they went both of them together.

John 19:16-17 So he delivered Him over to them to be crucified. So they took Yeshua, and <u>He went out, bearing His own cross</u>, to the place called The Place of a Skull, which in Aramaic is called Golgotha.

Genesis 22:14 So Abraham called the name of that place, "Adonai will be seen"; as it is said to this day, "On the mount of Adonai it shall be seen."

John 8:56 "Your father Abraham rejoiced that he would see My day. He saw it and was glad."

Numbers 19:2 "This is the statute of the Torah that Adonai has commanded: Tell the people of Israel to bring you a <u>red heifer</u> without defect, in which there is no blemish, and on which a yoke has never come.

Revelation 17:3-4 And he carried me away in the spirit into a wilderness, and I saw a woman sitting on a <u>scarlet beast</u> that was full of blasphemous names, and it had seven heads and ten horns. The woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet, and adorned with gold and jewels and pearls, holding in her hand a golden cup full of abominations and the impurities of her sexual immorality.

Numbers 19:9 And a man who is clean shall gather up the ashes of the heifer and deposit them outside the camp in a clean place. And they shall be kept for the water for impurity for the conger-gation of the people of Israel; it is a sin offering.

Revelation 17:6-7 And I saw the woman, drunk with the blood of the holy ones, the blood of the martyrs of Yeshua. When I saw her, I marveled greatly ['with great admirations' – KJV]. But the angel said to me, "Why do you marvel? I will tell you the mystery of the woman, and of the beast with seven heads and ten horns that carries her.

Exodus 19:16 On the morning of the third day there were thunders and lightnings and a thick cloud on the mountain and a very loud trumpet blast, so that all the people in the camp trembled.

Acts 2:1-2 When the day of Shavuot arrived, they were all together in one place. And suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting.

Exodus 19:18 Now Mount Sinai was wrapped in smoke because Adonai had descended on it in <u>fire</u>. The smoke of it went up like the smoke of a kiln, and the whole mountain trembled greatly.

Acts 2:3 And divided tongues as of fire appeared to them and rested on each one of them.

Acts 2:4,8 And they were all filled with the holy spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the spirit gave them utterance... "And how is it that we hear, each of us in his own native language?"

Exodus Rabbah 5:9 – R' Yochanan said: "The sound went forth from God and split into seventy sounds, i.e., into seventy different languages, in order that all the nations would understand what was being said. Furthermore, each and every nation heard the sound of God's voice in its native language..."

1Kings 6:20 The inner sanctuary was <u>twenty cubits long</u>, <u>twenty cubits wide</u>, and <u>twenty cubits high</u>, and he overlaid it with pure gold. He also overlaid an altar of cedar.

Revelation 21:16 The city is laid out in a square, its length equal to its width. With his rod he measured the city at 1,500 miles, with length, width and height the same.
