CHAYEI SARAH - חיי שרה

Genesis 23:1-25:18

... ויהיו חיי שרה

And they were – the life of Sarah – ...

ויהיו = 37

(*vayi'yu*)

Genesis 23:2

And Sarah died at Kiriath-arba (that is, Hebron) in the land of Canaan, and Abraham went in to mourn for Sarah **and to weep for her**.

ולבכתה
(*v'liv'cotah*)



ולב הכת
(*valeiv hucat*)

“and the heart is crushed”

Genesis 23:19

After this, Abraham buried Sarah his wife in the cave of the field of Machpelah east of Mamre (that is, Hebron) in the land of Canaan.

= 4970

Genesis 47:30

“And I will lie with my fathers. Carry me out of Egypt and bury me in their burying place.” He answered, “I will do as you have said.”

Genesis 24:1

Now Abraham was old, well advanced in years. And Adonai had blessed Abraham **in everything**.
