For the Girls:

BLESSING OVER SINGLES

How blessed are those who dwell in Your house, continually praising You. How blessed is the person whose strength is in You; the highways to Zion are in their heart. For Adonai is a sun and shield. Adonai gives grace and honor. No good thing will He withhold from those who walk uprightly. Adonai of hosts – how blessed is the person who trusts in You!

BLESSING OVER THE HUSBAND

How blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked nor stand in the path of sinners, nor sit in the seat of scoffers. But his delight is in the Torah of Adonai, and in His Torah he meditates day and night. He will be like a tree firmly planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in its season and its leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers.

EISHET CHAYIL

(abbreviated)

A woman of valor, who can find? Far beyond pearls is her value. Her husband's heart relies on her and he shall lack no fortune. She repays his good, but never his harm, all the days of her life. She seeks out wool and linen, and her hands work willingly. She is like a merchant's ships, from afar she brings her sustenance. She arises while it is yet night and gives food to her household and a portion to her handmaids. She envisions a field and buys it. From the fruit of her handiwork she plants a vineyard. She girds herself with strength and makes her arms strong. She senses that her gain is good; her lamp does not go out at night. Strength and dignity are her clothing, and she smiles at the future. She opens her mouth in wisdom, and the teaching of kindness is on her tongue. She looks well to the ways of her household, and the bread of laziness she does not eat. Her children rise up and bless her; her husband also, and he praises her: *Many daughters have done nobly, but you excel them all*. Charm is deceitful and beauty is vain, but a woman who fears Adonai, she shall be praised. Give her but the fruit of her hands and let her works praise her in the gates.

BLESSING OVER ISRAEL

Pray for the peace of Jerusalem. May they prosper who love you. May peace be within your walls and prosperity within your palaces. For the sake of my brothers and my friends I will now say, may peace be within you. For the sake of the house of Adonai our God, I will seek your good.

KIDDUSH

The sixth day. Thus the heavens and earth were finished, and all their array. On the seventh day God completed His work which He had done, and He abstained on the seventh day from all His work which He had done. God blessed the seventh day and hallowed it, because on it He abstained from all His work which God created to make.

(Raise the Cup)

ALL: We thank You, our Father, for the holy vine of Your servant David, which You made known to us through Your Servant Yeshua. Yours is the glory forever.

(all Drink)

Blessed are You, Adonai, our God, King of the universe, who sanctified us with His commandments, took pleasure in us, and with love and favor gave us His holy Shabbat as a heritage, a memorial of the creation, a day which is the beginning of our sacred gatherings, a memorial of our exodus from Egypt. For us did You choose and us did You sanctify from every tribe and nation. And Your holy Shabbat, with love and favor did You give us as a heritage. Blessed are You, Adonai, who sanctifies the Shabbat.

(Raise the Bread)

ALL: We thank You, Father, for the life and knowledge which You made known to us through Your Servant Yeshua. Yours is the glory forever. Just as this broken bread was scattered over the hills, and was gathered and became one, so let Your assembly be gathered together from the ends of the earth into Your Kingdom. For Yours is the glory and the power through Yeshua the Messiah forever.

Deliver her from all evil and make her complete in Your love, and gather her, the sanctified, from the four winds to Your Kingdom which You have prepared for her. For Yours is the power and the glory. Let grace come and let this world pass away! Hoshanna to the Son of David! Everyone who is holy, let him come. Everyone who is not holy, let him repent.
